## The countdown is on! Update your DSPT by 30 June 2025

If you run an adult social care service in England, it's time to get ready for the 30 June 2025 to update your Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT).

The DSPT isn't just a box-ticking exercise. It's an essential, annual self-assessment that shows you're taking data protection and cyber security seriously – and that you're following good practice to keep people's confidential information safe.

The **Better Security, Better Care programme** offers a wide range of **free support** – no matter where you are in your DSPT journey.

#### **Reminder DSPT emails queries**

For those who have received reminder emails, please see our guidance below:

1 – If the site has never had someone register against it individually and it has not previously been included in a publication, I expect that no reminder is sent? **If the site does not have an admin user set up, they would not receive an email.** 

2 – If the site has never had someone register against it individually but it has previously been included in a publication, would anyone receive a reminder? No, they would not receive a reminder. If the site does not have an admin user set up, they would not receive an email.

3 – If the site has had someone register against the site in the past (be this the same or a different person from the one who is registered against the HO publication), then whomever has registered against the site will be receiving the reminder emails. **Yes, if the site had someone historically had a user set up then they would still receive a reminder email**

# Digital care records help local care provider to deliver safer, better and personalised care

The Digitising Social Care programme team at Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes Integrated Care System has been supporting local care providers to embrace digital social care records (DSCR).

When Sembia Johnson joined M&C Home Support Limited in Bedfordshire as Registered Manager last autumn, she completed the Data Security and Protection Toolkit and applied for an NHSmail account, which in turn enabled them to migrate to the Nourish digital records system.

"We have better control in terms of monitoring and auditing... it ensures better accuracy, better communication, better compliance and better accountability," she says. "The alert system is fantastic – if there's something we need to be aware of, we know about it immediately."

Although Sembia acknowledges there have been some challenges with internet connection and digital literacy, she is certain the DSCR has saved staff time, improved safety and improved quality of care.

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#### Completing your DSPT ahead of the June deadline

The Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT) is an online self-assessment tool to help adult social care providers in England to store and share information safely. It shows you what you need to do to keep people's information safe, and to protect your business from the risk of a data breach or a cyber attack. It covers both paper and digital records.

It also reassures everyone you work with that you are taking data security seriously, which in turn can open up access to NHSmail and shared records systems such as GP Connect and proxy access. Care providers must have an up-to-date DSPT in place to meet NHS contracts – and local authorities and CQC inspectors increasingly expect you to have it.

Care providers should complete the toolkit at least once a year.

- Register for the DSPT including how to register if you have multiple services and sites
- Complete to Approaching Standards and Standards Met
- Publish your DSPT
- Access free, official support from the Better Security, Better Care programme
